Mandatory Arbitration Agreements after the U. S. Supreme Court's Decision in Epic Systems Corp. v. Lewis.

Another challenge to mandatory arbitration of employment disputes fell flat in Epic Systems Corporation v. Lewis. This time the attack was on class action waivers. In a 5-4 decision, the United States Supreme Court ruled that employers can use arbitration agreements to prevent employees from bringing employment class actions.

The Empty Chair Doesn't Need to be an Empty Opportunity: Apportioning Fault to Immune Employers

This article considers the current status of Ohio case law on the ability of tortfeasors to seek an apportionment of liability to non-party employers who are immune under Ohio's Workers' Compensation laws. In addition, this article examines (1) the laws concerning allocation of fault to a non-party, (2) whether a legally viable theory of liability is required for allocation of fault against non-party, (3) the limited case law on this issue, and (4) the possibility of bringing a contribution claim against the non-party employer.
