It's The Most Wonderful Time of the Year - time to take stock of the year that was in OACTA amicus filings. The year 2013 brought change to the Supreme Court of Ohio as three new justices took the bench: Justices Kennedy, O'Neill and French replaced Justices McGee Brown, Cupp and Stratton. Fortunately, this change did not dampen OACTA's success before the Court, with three favorable decisions to date on issues ranging from the admissibility of "write-off" evidence to recreational user immunity.

Insurance Coverage Committee Update By: Michael M. Neltner, Committee Chair

The following cases represent the more relevant insurance coverage cases decided by the Ohio Supreme Court, federal courts, and lower state appellate courts this year. Four of the cases involve the continuing litigation over Ohio's 2005 Employer Intentional Tort ("EIT") statute and three of these have been appealed so far to the Supreme Court, which has accepted two of them for review.

This summary will also appear on the OACTA Insurance Coverage website, which includes most EIT Supreme Court and lower appellate court decisions related to the interpretation of R.C. 2745.01 to date, as well as a number of the more relevant trial court decisions.




OACTA Diversity Scholarship Program
